

Session title	Daisy Duck and the perfect nest	
Key question	Which nest is best?	
Session description	Follow the story of Daisy Duck as she searches for the ideal nesting place. Whose advice will she follow – frog's, otter's or flamingo's? What will Daisy and her ducklings need? Can we find her a perfect place to nest here at Martin Mere?

Duration	30 mins +	

Curriculum links	EYFS: Understanding the world 3- and 4-year-olds will be learning to: - Use all their senses in hands-on exploration of natural materials. - Talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary. - Understand the key features of the life cycle of a plant and an animal. - Begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things. Children in reception will be learning to: - Explore the natural world around them. - Describe what they see, hear and feel whilst outside. - Recognise some environments that are different from the one in which they live. - Understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them. KS1 Science - Identify and name a variety of common animals. - Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals. - Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different types of animals. - Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals for survival (water, food and air).

Session Outline	Time
Introduction	5 mins
Learners are given a brief intro to WWT Martin Mere and are introduced to the key question: Which nest is best?	

Activity 1 – Observing water birds.	5 mins
Learners meet the ducks on swan lake or visit a nest.	
Activity 2 – The story of Daisy Duck and her quest for the perfect nest.	10 mins
Learners are introduced to the story of Daisy Duck, who talks to a variety of creatures before she decides on how to build her nest. Learners help to build up a verbal list of 'nesting needs'.	
Activity 3 – Searching for a nest	15 mins
Learners search in the bird collection for a nest, (which may or may not be a mallard's).
